Dear Participant:

The planning for the 102nd Annual Strawberry Festival is well under way. Dates for this year are June 2nd – June 5th. It is our goal to continue the city's long held traditions established so many years ago.

We invite you and your group to join us in the Strawberry Festival Grand Parade being held June 4th at 11 AM. This year's theme is "Strawberries in Paradise".

Attached is the Grand Parade entry Application, rules and staging area map. If your group is planning on joining us, we ask you to return the entry application promptly. **Entries must be received by May 31st to avoid the late fee.** This will give us the time needed to finalize our planning to align and stage a safe parade for all. **Entries received after May 31st will be charged a \$10 late fee. Entries will not be accepted after Thursday June 2nd, 2011.** Registration fees are non-refundable.

Horse check-in will be on the access road by Walgreens.

Check-in for all other types of entries will be in Dr. Clark's Dental office parking lot located near the end of Market Street. Staging for these will be on Market Street, part of the River Center Parking Lot and Bob Smith Park. **Please enter from the South Main Street side.**

Check-in opens at 7 AM the morning of the parade and closes at 10AM. Judging will begin at 8 AM and cease at 10AM. Please have your entry ready for judging at this time. Entries checking in after 9:30 AM will not be judged.

RULES
2011 Lebanon Strawberry Festival Grand Parade
Saturday June 4th 2011

We invite you to join us for the 102nd Strawberry Festival Grand Parade in Lebanon, Oregon. Our application is enclosed. The rules that follow are designed for the safety and enjoyment of all participating.

CHECK IN OPENS: 7AM
JUDGING BEGINS: 8AM
JUDGING CEASES: 10AM
CHECK IN CLOSES: 10AM
PARADE BEGINS: 11AM

Check-in headquarters will be located at Dr. Clark's Dental Office

Please have one representative check in and pick up your entry number and staging location. All entries must check in to receive their parade number and staging location.

Due to limited space No support vehicles (vehicles not in the parade) will be allowed in the staging area and no numbers will be available until the morning of the parade.

Entries must decorate for the theme to compete for trophies.

By STATE LAW and for SAFETY PURPOSES, no Items of any Nature can be thrown from any entry. **It is unlawful for any person during or in connection with a parade or public gathering to throw any material or object from the parade route or location to or for those viewing the parade, or walking or driving near the parade or public gathering. (Ord. 2324 § 1 (part), 2002:Ord. 1987 § 4, 1986) Please be aware that this could result in a fine up To \$500**

Parade participants are asked to keep pace with the line of march. Keep within 50 feet of the entry in front of you.

No firearms or explosive devices of any nature shall be Carried on the parade route except by organized Federal, State Military, the 40ET8 Locomotive, NW Civil War Council, and any educational historical organization.

No alcohol, drug, drug paraphernalia, or replicas of Any of these will be allowed in the parade.

The Lebanon Strawberry Festival and Parade Coordinators Reserve the right for safety purposes to deny entry either Prior to or during parade to an entry not adhering to the Rules.

Please note parade applications **must** be Submitted by May 31st, 2011 to avoid \$10 late fee

Trophies: Trophies will be awarded to 1st-3rd place winners in all categories, and to the Sweepstakes, Mayor's Choice, Queen's Choice, and Chairperson's Choice. Trophies will be handed out to the winners as they Enter on to the parade route.

Note to Horse Entries: In order to be judged for trophies, both you and your horse should be made up to the parade theme. All horses Must be fed oats or dry feed for a few days prior, this request is made for the benefit of all. Horse entries must be pre-registered and Have an entry number to be judged. Horses will disband on 3rd street.

Parade Route length: 2.5 miles. Parade begins at Market St and Santiam Hwy. and proceeds north along hwy 20 to Rose St. then west on Rose St where it will disband onto 3rd and 5th streets
